- Examples of situations that could be fair housing problems:
 - O Prospect who uses a wheelchair can't get into rental office
 - O Hispanic complains of racial slurs by neighbors
 - O Prospect is told there are no available vacancies
 - O Prospect is told to return later because there's no one in the office
 - O Resident asks maintenance to walk her dog
 - O Employees laugh at racial joke
 - O Resident asks management to stop spraying for pesticides
 - O Resident claims she's made 5 requests for RA and has been ignored
 - O Resident complains of Christmas decorations
 - O Manager of elderly property requires residents to provide medical contact information
